#### Town centre routes

Jeremy gave an update based on information from Derek Stidder. Green cycle symbols have been implemented along the entire east-west route, and signing should be in place shortly. The toucan crossing across Roman way has undergone a feasibility study; detailed design is commencing following TfL financial agreement, with a view to implementation in 2009/10. There has been no progress over North End. The junctions and the mandatory cycle lane in Roman Way have reached the detailed design stage, and Derek will be carrying out the consultation in the next few weeks. All the scheme proposals have to go to the TMCC, and Derek will send them to us electronically.
